Rider Specifications

- Applicants under 18 require a Parent or Guardian to sign this form
- Physically, riders must be able and reasonably fit, well balanced on a horse at all gaits
- As a matter of safety; THE INSTRUCTOR, Sam Caporn reserves the right to recommend that you do not ride, and in such a case your enrolment will be transferred to auditor status.

Horse Specifications

- Must already be started under saddle
- Please **do not** bring horses with very serious behavioural problems on a course.
- Stallions are not permitted.

Rider Requirements

- A Basic Equipment kit is required comprising a Natural (Rope) Halter, 12ft Line, Carrot Stick and 6ft Savvy String together with your saddle, **riding boots/shoes* and hard hat***. For Level 2 and higher courses; you will require a 22ft line, extra Carrot Stick, Snaffle Bridle and optionally a bareback pad.
- If you need to purchase this equipment, you can find it at the web address www.samcaporn.com.au then click on the shop link.

For Insurance purposes the following is required

- Australian standard approved helmet to be worn whilst riding. (If you chose to ride without a helmet you **will not** be Insured)
- Appropriately heeled shoes (no laces) or boots.

Terms & Conditions

- Clinic date[s] are set by Sam Caporn and full day payments are required regardless of student availability to attend.
- At any time, it is the **absolute discretion** of the INSTRUCTOR Sam Caporn that he may:
 - (a) Revoke approval for the APPLICANT to attend or participate in the COURSE
 - (b) Recommend that the APPLICANT transfer to 'auditor' status
 - (c) Make an adjustment to location / pricing / course structure / refund of course payments
- The APPLICANT agrees to release and discharge Sam Caporn in respect of all liability to the APPLICANT for loss or damage of any kind whether for personal injury, death or property damage which the APPLICANT may suffer in attending the COURSE, howsoever caused.
- The APPLICANT hereby indemnifies the INSTRUCTOR from any loss, liability or damage or cost that may be incurred by the INSTRUCTOR
 - (a) as a result of any act or omission, whether caused by negligence of the applicant or otherwise
 - (b) in respect of any injury, loss or damage any person who may accompany the APPLICANT to the COURSE may suffer whilst at the COURSE.
- This Agreement, Releases and Indemnities shall be binding upon the APPLICANT, the APPLICANTS legal representative, heirs and next of kin and that this agreement may be pleaded in bar to any cause of action commenced in any court contrary to the **Term & Conditions**.

Note: Various words and phrases used in this agreement shall have the following meanings: - "the INSTRUCTOR" also includes any directors, shareholders, employees, agents or sub-contractors who may run or assist in running the COURSE: "the COURSE" refers to any instructions, training or demonstrations relating to the starting, training, selection, care, handling and riding of horses.

Cancellation Policy

- Student deposits to reserve your place and pre-paid auditor tickets are not refundable. Please consider this when reserving your place or booking your position on the clinic.
- If the clinic date[s] or venue is rescheduled/amended at the discretion of Sam Caporn or the venue, any deposit or pre-paid fees will be transferred to the rescheduled dates, at either the same or an alternative venue within the same area.
- In the event of rescheduling, refunds will be considered at the sole discretion of Sam Caporn. Only in the event that Sam Caporn cancels the clinic will student deposits, auditor tickets & any other advanced fees paid will be refunded. A full refund beyond these terms will only be considered upon receiving a Veterinary certificate.

Riders Acknowledgement and Declaration

I declare that:

- Physically I am able and reasonable fit; well balanced on a horse.
- The horse I will use on this course does not have any serious behavioural problems, which may disrupt the clinic or other horses or other riders. I will accept and follow all reasonable directions of the INSTRUCTOR.
- I am aware that activities involving horses can be dangerous and unpredictable and that I can be injured or killed. I accept all risks of personal injury, death or property damage to myself or caused to others.
- I am aware I may be personally liable for injury or damage to other horses, people or property that is caused by myself or my horse and I have been advised that I should insure myself against such risks.
- I have fully read and understand the **Terms & Conditions** on this form and I agree that all terms and conditions are included in the Agreement between the instructor and myself.

To secure my position within the course I understand that my \$150.00 deposit is **non – refundable**. I have processed the payment prior to submitting this application form; I understand that full payment is required **14 days prior** to the course date.
